# Shred-It Event

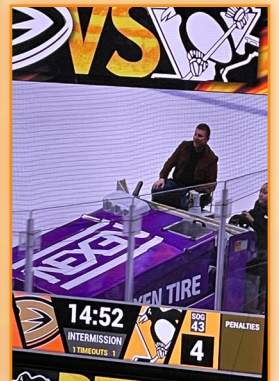
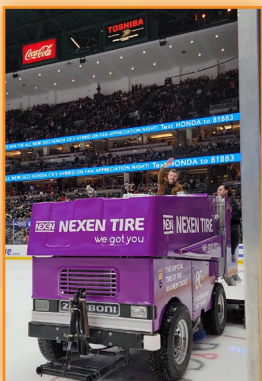

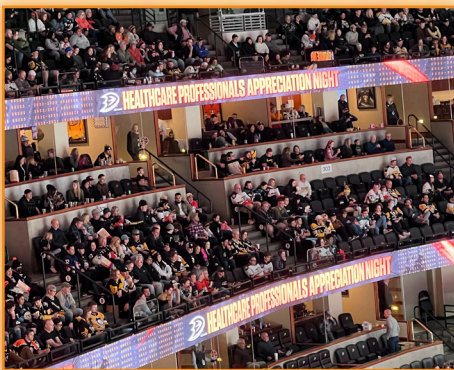
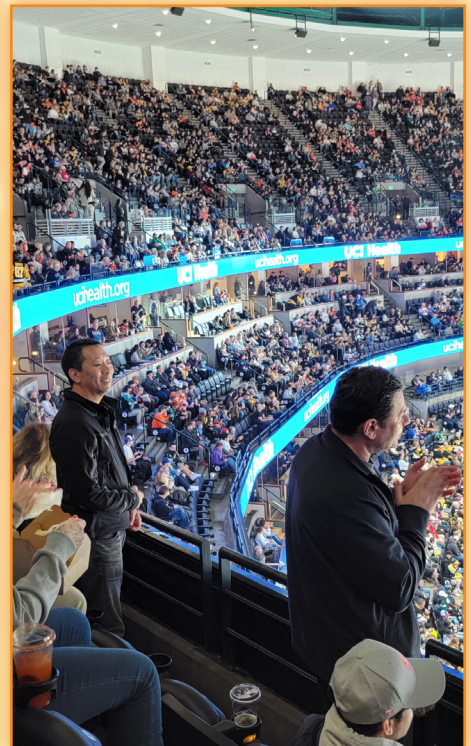
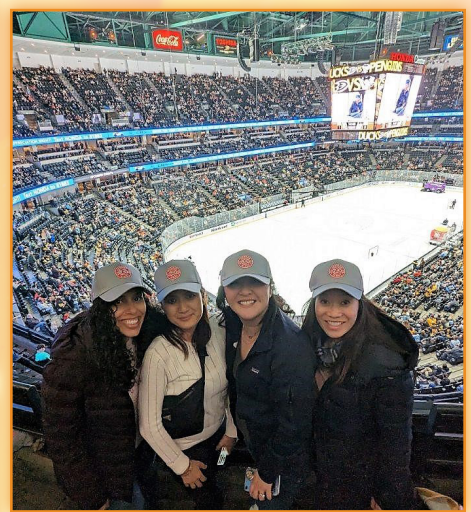


# Healthcare Appreciation Night with the Anaheim Ducks

The food was delicious and the atmosphere was great! Members and staff all socialized and we hope some long term connections were made. We are planning another mixer this fall.



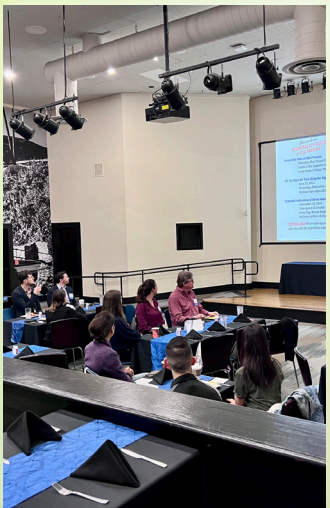
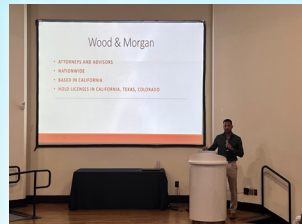

# EXTENDED INDICATIONS OF DIRECT ANTERIOR COMPOSITE RESIN RESTORATIONS

A turning point in the late 1990s and early 2000s was the introduction of single-hue composite systems along with more natural or “tooth-like” layering techniques also called “anatomic build-up technique”, “trendy 3-layer concept”, or “natural layering concept”. Multi-hue systems have many shades for either enamel and dentin but they fail to cover some of the extreme chromatic ranges found in patients. The shade guide is also a critical element in the process. Shade selection is more difficult when the shade guide is not made with the same material and thickness as the restoration. In prefabricated anatomic dual-laminate shade guides, the selected enamel tab is “nested” over the dentin sample. The combination of different shades of enamel and dentin can be instantly compared with the tooth structure (enamel sample, dentin sample and the enamel/dentin combination in a single observation). These innovations as well as many different aspects of the direct application of composite resins (isolation, bonding, texturing, and polishing) will be presented.

## PASCAL MAGNE, DMD, MSc, PhD

Dr. Magne is currently the Director of the Center for Education and Research in Biomimetic Dentistry (CER-BRD) in Beverly Hills, California. From 2004 to 2022, Dr. Magne was the Don and Sybil Harrington Foundation Professor of Esthetic Dentistry in the Division of Restorative Sciences, University of Southern California, Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry. He graduated from the University of Geneva Dental School, Switzerland (1989 DMD, 1992 MSc and 2002 PhD). He lectured at the same university beginning in 1989 until 1997 (fixed prosthodontics and occlusion, operative dentistry, and endodontics). From 1997-1999, he was a visiting associate professor at the Minnesota Dental Research Center for Biomaterials and Biomechanics, University of Minnesota, School of Dentistry. From 1999-2004 he was a senior lecturer in the Division of Fixed Prosthodontics and Occlusion at the University of Geneva Dental School until he was recruited to the University of Southern California in 2004. Dr. Magne is a recipient of multiple awards (Swiss Science Foundation, Swiss Foundation for Medical-Biological Grants, 2002 Young Investigator Award from the International Association for Dental Research, 2007 and 2009 Judson C. Hickey Scientific Writing Award of the Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry). He is also the author of numerous articles on esthetics and adhesive dentistry and is an internationally known mentor and lecturer. Dr. Magne authored the book *Bonded Porcelain Restorations in the Anterior Dentition—A Biomimetic Approach* which took the dental world by storm in 2002 and has been translated into 12 languages. His new two-volume book *Biomimetic Restorative Dentistry* has been recently released and is equally astounding. He is a founding member of the Academy of Biomimetic Dentistry and a mentor of the Bio-Emulation think-tank group. In 2012, he launched a revolutionary approach to the teaching of dental morphology, function, and esthetics through a progressive “2D/3D/4D approach”.

# ENDODONTIC GUIDES FOR CHALLENGING CASES AND APICAL SURGERIES

Endodontics has seen significant technological advances in the last decade enhancing the precision and predictability of treatment. Although endodontic treatment is a predictable procedure with a long-term tooth retention rates and success, failures and treatment limitations may still be present due to case limitations. The purpose of this presentation is to show and discuss clinical scenarios of extremely difficult endodontic cases that could be treated and managed using 3D printing and Static Endodontic Guides.

Dr. David Kelliny earned his Bachelors in Dental Surgery from Cairo University in 1992; He graduated with a Doctor of Dental Surgery degree from University of Southern California in 1998 and earned a Certificate in Endodontics also from USC in 2001.

Dr. Kelliny is one of the first endodontists to integrate dental implants into their practice, he lectured extensively about Dental implants and the use of planning software such as BlueSkyPlan, Simplant, Co-diagnostix; integrating 3D software and Dental implants into the modern endodontic practice and General dentistry. He lectured at local and international levels about Surgical implantology and the use of custom surgical guides for implant placement and Endodontic surgeries.

He is currently a part time Clinical Assistant Professor at the Herman Ostrow School of dentistry of USC post graduate Endodontic program; he was the director of an elective surgical implant course for endodontic residents between 2008-2013. Dr. Kelliny has been teaching at USC since 2002; he is involved in teaching and lecturing residents on various aspects of endodontics with a specific emphasis on surgical endodontics, 3D endodontics and Dental Implants.

Dr. Kelliny is a member of the American Dental Association, California Dental Association, Western Los Angeles Dental Society, American Association of Endodontists, American Dental Society Anesthesiology and International Congress of Implantologists.
